Last month, the Construction Manager Certification Institute (CMCI) welcomed the [2,000th Certified Construction Manager \(CCM\)](#), Kevin R. Sanderson, CCM, project manager at San Francisco's Bay Area Rapid Transit System (BART). The roster of CCMs has doubled in the last five years, and grown by more than 50 percent since 2010.

Crossing the 2,000th certification mark is a major milestone and a great achievement for the CCM program. As the program continues to grow rapidly, 2013 is proving to be one of the biggest years ever for CCM application submissions to the Board of Governors.



The [U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics \(BLS\)](#) projects that nearly 90,000 building project managers will be added between 2010 and 2020, with all of them holding at least an associate's degree. The median pay for these positions in 2010 was over \$83,000 per year.

How Many Points Do You Have Towards Your CCM Renewal?



CMCI released [Recert Track](#) in March of 2013. The Recertification Tracking Portal was designed to help you keep track of all your CCM Renewal Points along with those other licenses or credentials you may hold. Using the portal, you are able to upload and keep track of all the points and documents you accumulate during your current recertification period. CMCI recommends that you load your

activities into your profile as soon as you complete each activity. All the recent activities taken through CMAA will automatically be loaded into your profile within one month of the activity or creation of your profile.
