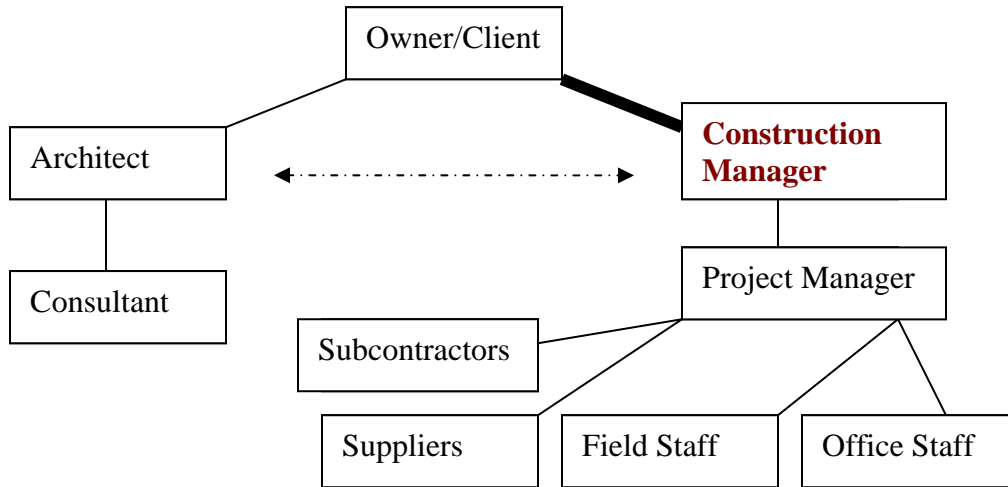


Sample Organizational Chart Showing CM in the role of "Responsible in Charge."

In this simple chart, the relationship between the Construction Manager and the Owner/Client is obvious. No matter how large the project, there must be a *bona fide* relationship between the owner and the CM that shows that the construction manager was operating in the Owner's best interest.

In your organizational chart, please be certain to list the titles and names of the individuals who worked with you on the projects(s) that you are submitting as qualifying for the 48 months Responsible in Charge requirement. The dotted horizontal line between the Architect and Construction Manager indicates consultative activities; however, since there is no formal relationship between the architect and the staff, contractors, and suppliers, the architect is NOT the responsible in charge.

It is in your best interest to be as neat as possible with your chart. While the Governors prefer computer produced charts, you may submit a hand drawn one.
