Founded: San Francisco was founded on June 29, 1776, by Spanish colonists. Becoming the 31st State in 1850.

Gold Rush Boom: The 1849 Gold Rush brought rapid growth, transforming it from a small settlement to a booming city.

Iconic Bridge: The Golden Gate Bridge, construction completed in 1937, is one of the most recognized symbols in the world.

Cable Cars: San Francisco's cable car system, established in 1873, is the last manually operated system of its kind.

Alcatraz: Alcatraz Island served as a federal prison from 1934 to 1963, housing infamous criminals like Al Capone.

1906 Earthquake: A devastating earthquake in 1906 destroyed much of the city, leading to a massive rebuilding effort.

Chinatown: San Francisco's Chinatown, established in 1848, is the oldest and one of the largest in North America.

Summer of Love: The Haight-Ashbury neighborhood was the epicenter of the 1967 Summer of Love, a defining moment in the counterculture movement.

Fog: The city's famous fog, often called "Karl," rolls in frequently, creating picturesque and moody landscapes.

Tech Hub: Today, San Francisco is a major tech hub, with Silicon Valley nearby, headquarters to many of the world's leading technology companies, including Apple, Google, Nvidia, Open AI, Salesforce, Autodesk, and Meta.
